In this connection, we place the following for your consideration and favourable sanction.

1. The reimbursement of House Rent for leased accommodation to officers in our bank is far below compared to the market level Rents especially in Metro Cities and Mid cap cities. This needs to be revised substantially upward to suit the comparable market conditions.
2. The job of officers is transferable and officers undergo frequent transfers. More than $50 \%$ of the Officer employees are availing the Leased accommodation.
3. The Officers on transfers have to shell out huge sum out of their pocket to book a decent House for a decent living and the cost of rental is more nowadays in general in all the places and in metros the same is not less than Rs.25000/-per month.
4. The present reimbursement scheme is far below the market level.
5. Peer Banks like State Bank of India, Bank of Baroda have upwardly revised substantially in the recent past. (BOB's circular enclosed).
6. The inflation over years on the House rents across India shall be taken into account for upward revision of the rental ceilings.
Under the circumstances we request you to look into the matter and consider suitable upward revision of rentals in tune with the market rates and as available in other banks.
