You are all aware that UFBU has given a call for 48 hours Strike commencing from 6 am on 10/02/2014 to 6 am on 12/02/2014 demanding expeditious wage settlement for employees and officers and also halt the Banking Reforms process.

The IBA which offered initial offer of 5% on Pay slip component has improved their offer to 9.5% and in the last round of talks have improved a meager increase of 0.5%. Agitated over the meager offer, UFBU gave a call for 48 hours strike on 10th February 2014 and 11th February 2014.

Comrades, the strike is forced on the Bank Employees and Officers. We advise all our Office Bearers and CC Members and Members to participate in all the action programmes of UFBU and to make the 48 hours Strike a Grand Success.

All Officers including the Probationary Officers and those who are going to retire shortly shall participate in the Strike action. The entire exercise of our national organization AIBOA is to ensure fair reasonable and respectable wage revision for Bank officer commensurate to the accountability, risk and unrestricted working hours. The Endeavour of our national organization AIBOA is to ensure a better wage revision for all officers in general and to Young Officers in particular. Hence it is imperative on our part to ensure the success of the strike to realize our desired goal of achieving a fair reasonable and respectable wage revision.
